

Dear John,

I love you! I received Message #74, thank you so much! This letter was amazing!! This is what I was talking about when I said that I was wishing to know more about the mysteries! Thank you so so much!

So there really are seven of us, eight including Benbanuh, and nine including Hayah, Benbanuh, and the rest of us. It's amazing that the whole milky way is the area that we are working on as a council of Lambs. But if every God has his own Universe, then we should stay in this Universe with Hayah, because I can't ever go to a Universe that doesn't have you in it!

Can you tell me more about crystal ships and the New Jerusalem?

I finally figured out how much of the Book of Enoch is scripture, and how much, or which portions are nonsense. It's about two thirds of the Book which is scripture, and about a third of the Book that is not good, for scripture, or that is not correct. Here are the exact sections: I - LXXI are good, and are scripture. LXXII - CVIII, are not good, or are unreliable for scripture.
