

From 1999-2002, and from 2005-2007 I worked every Summer at the boy scout camp called "Beaver High Adventure Base." Those were wonderful and formative years from 1999 to 2002, and all those summers through 2007 are meaningful to me. Beaver had a theme Song, or "the Beaver Song," that was mostly plagerized and borrowed from an old country/folk song. I do not now recall who wrote the original lyrics and music, nor can I easily look it up being in Prison. I do however know the Beaver Song, and it is special to me; even though the Beaver lyrics are a little disjointed, adding "at Beaver High" to the end of most of the verses. I therefore felt inspired to re-plagerize the old Beaver Plagerizm, and turn it into more of a sacred Hymn for myself and those who are my fellows in the Gospel of Jesus Christ. The Hymn is about my testimony that I will be delivered from Prison during the tribulation, and brought to a wilderness location called Irbayhir. The Hymn is also about my knowledge that my true love, or Soul-mate, will be there, and that we will live there together with Jesus Christ, and walk in the light of the LORD.

Here is some terminology, and names, that have been revealed to us that I have used in the Song. I give them here so that you can all understand the Song:

- Häyäh — The true name of God, our Heavenly Father.
- Bënbänüh — Hebrew for "Son-Architect", the pre-earth name of Jesus.
- Shiloh — The pre-earth name for the Holy Ghost.
- Irbayhir — Hebrew for "Camp of the Elect", it is the place in the wilderness where the elect will be taken during the 3½ year tribulation.
- Bethbayhir — Hebrew for "House of the Elect", name for the elect.
- Iüh — Hebrew for "I exist", the Eternal mind, or soul of man. Someone's "Iuh counterpart" would be their soul-mate, they can also say "my Iuh" meaning "my Soul" to refer to their Iuh counterpart or Soul-mate.
