

The Testimony of Arieah

1. This is a Testimony of Arieah which she wrote in the thirteenth year after the Resurrection of her Lord Esus the Anointed.
2. And she saith: It verily came to pass that in the evening of the first day on the second week of the third month of the year the Apostles were gathered and we did partake of communion together and did pray and did receive a vision of the Lord.
3. And behold he instructed us in the ministry and told us in what nations we should continue to sojourn or where we should go to preserve the truth in the world.
4. After all these things I did retire to my house with mine husband Bartholomew

and this night he did sleep with a sister, wherefore I was alone in our bedroom and did pray before the Lord.

5. For verily I remembered the teaching of the Lord to pray both together and in private, wherefore I also had close communion with the Lord he being mine husband in his mortality.

6. And now as I did pray a light shone in mine room and I did look up and see the Lord standing just above my bed before me.

7. Now he did shake my hand and embraced me and did give me a holy kiss and we did talk about many things being overwhelmed with gladness to visit with each other again.

8. And he did also say that he looked after me always, but that I would eventually be burned for my testimony but to be steadfast in righteousness as the pain would be taken from me and that I would be taken by him in that day.

9. Now he did say unto me; Aricah, remember that the Holy Anointing is a central ordinance unto the entire gospel plan.

10. And behold where the Holy Anointing is not, or where it is not understood is where the gospel is not.

11. And remember when I said that when Mary Anointed me that, that would be a memorial unto her for all generations.

12. For without that ordinance families cannot be bound for all the Eternities to come, and therefore all women shall think of her when they do this ordinance until the end of the world.

13. And now Esus also said unto me, Aricah, you see me by the power of the light, and the light that illuminates your eyes is the power by which Seers see, which are the corner stones upon which the churches shall be established, even as Peter is named after this principle.

14. And now when ye are transfigured your physical eyes do come in one with your spiritual eyes, wherefore ye only see me spiritually but it is as if ye see me physically because ye are transfigured.

15. And now when Esus had said this, I did look down upon myself and I was as an Angel also.

16. Now I knew this could only be accomplished through the Priesthood power that was within me, wherefore I praised my Lord for showing these truths unto me.

17. And verily after all this Esus did instruct me to go on the marrow down unto the sea and to immerse myself into the Church of the Firstborn and that I could do

this by the power of the Holy Spirit and according to my Priestess-hood.

18. And now Esus said unto me, that after this I would be prepared in all things to go about the ministry, and I would be empowered from on high to fulfill my mission in this world.

19. Behold on the morrow I did go down as Esus instructed me and immersed myself in the water of the sea, and I had already had communion with the general assembly but had not been immersed for this purpose as of yet.

20. And now when I did come up out of the water I looked up into the heavens and I did see the burning candelabra in the temple of heaven, and the divine light of it filled my eyes and I did receive more light and intelligence from it than that could ever be attained from this world.

21. And now this is my testimony of the Anointed Savior and also the true beginning of my ministry over the Church in Philos. Wherefore I have been called as an Apostle of the Lord, and I do say unto the whole race of Israel, repent and believe on the Lord, and be baptized and receive all the ordinances and ye shall verily be saved. Amen!
