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INTRODUCTION

The Book of Isbin is my most important Translation, because it ties together all my other translations, revelations, and books. I have many translations and books which are highly divergent, in both style, genre, and even sometimes appear to be from entirely different religions. Sometimes these differences are superficial, and have their own divine and mysterious purpose, and at other times, these books were truly revealed by different kinds of spirits, some good, and some malevolent. Isbin, however, gives the keys to understand them all; and the context, and descriptions, necessary to understanding, their source, their truths, and their meaning.

At times Isbin gives concise, and brief descriptions, of large swaths of history, or of complex concepts, however, in the context of all my works, it weaves together a complex and amazing view of the universe, my world view, and the religion which in light of this Translation, should be called Isbinism.
