Didache 7, (Remember, these are the Baptismal instructions we followed.)

Didache 8:2, "And forgive us our debt, as we forgive our debtors."

Didache 10:5, "Remember your church, O Lord; save it from all evil, and perfect it in your love."

Didache 11:11, "You are not to condemn any prophet who has been approved and is true, and who acts on behalf of the earthly mystery of the church, even if he does not teach others to do what he himself does, since he has his judgement with God.

Didache 16:4-6, "... Then the world-deceiver will be manifest as a son of God. He will perform signs and wonders, and the earth will be delivered over into his hands. He will perform lawless deeds, unlike anything done from eternity. Then all human creation will come to the fire of testing, and many will fall away and perish, but those who endure in their faith will be saved by the curse itself. Then the signs of truth will be manifest: first a sign of a rip in the sky, then a sign of the sound of a trumpet, and third a resurrection of the dead.

I hope you have a Didache, or can get a copy. I am so grateful for yet another priceless Book! I love you! Our keys are true! I love you forever!
